Intended use and intended environment including standard options

The product is a standing frame for both anterior and posterior up right standing. The support given by using different accessories will compensate for the lack of function the child might have. As an accessory the Rocker can be mounted under the frame to make the product dynamic.

The target group for this device is disabled children with cerebral palsy (CP). The consequence of CP is either spasticity, reduced walking or standing skills and/or impairments in addition to their motor disability. Other effects with no relation to this device is intellectual, vision and hearing impairment.

Also children with muscular dystrophy, spina bifida, spinal cord injuries and neurological impairments can be subject to the device. An acknowledged classification of disabled persons, is the Gross Motor Function Classification System. The target group for this device is level II - IV.

The product comes in 3 sizes.

The product is an indoor product and can in the case of an emergency be taken outside.

## Description

- All nuts and bolt on this product must be checked and tightened to avoid failures
- Use a dry cloth to clean the product
- Visual inspection. Repair or replace any damaged or worn-out parts
- Ensure that all fasteners are in place and fitted correctly
- Check all fittings and buckles for signs of worn out
- Be aware of any MAX mark indications before adjustment
- Wipe off any residue and dirt from the product using a cloth with warm water and a mild detergent/soap and dry before use

Weekly

- Check that all castors are moving freely and that all wheel locks/brakes are easily activated
- Disinfect the product. please check the disinfection section in this User Guide for more information

Every 6 months

Check the condition of the upholstery and replace it if necessary

Annually - Inspec

- Inspect the frame for cracks or signs for worn-out parts and carry out annual service. Never use a product which appears to be substandard or faulty
  - The product has to be checked and tightened by a qualified technician at least every 12 months to avoid failures.
